Our system of medicine Ayurveda- the science of life, makes use of the advanced modern techniques in the diagnosis and symptom analysis through the Nidana Panchakas helps in assessing the nature, course and chronicity of any disease. Guduchyadi kwath parisheka is a remedy mentioned in Chikitsa sthana of charak samhita for vataj Yoniroga. So present study has been selected.

Aim

Review of Literature:

Causes of vata vitiation:

- Vegavarodha(Suppression of natural urges)
- Ratrijagarana (Vigil during night)
- Madya (Alcohol)
- Uccha Bhashana (Speaking aloud)
- Purvivata (exposure to eastern wind)
- Atimaithuna (excess sexual indulgence)
- Aghata (Injury)
- Raja (exposure of dust)

Vataja Yoni Roga causes and symptoms:²

If a woman having Vata body type, resorts to Vata increasing food and regimen, it causes Vata increase. The aggravated Vata gets located in the reproductive organs to produce

- Pipilika a sensation as if ants are crawling
- Supti- numbness and such other ailments caused by Vata in that place (reproductive organs).

Because of aggravated Vata, she gets untimely menstrual bleeding which is

- Phena frothy
- Ruksha dry and
- Sa syat sa shabda is associated with sound and pain.

Yoni - Parisheka

Hot fermentation to vagina is Yoni parisheka. It is done on external part of vagina for 5 to 10 minutes. Medicated oil or lukewarm water is poured from the height of 4 to 5 inches over the vagina. It reduces swelling and pain at vagina.

Guduchyadi Kwath:

It is prepared by boiling 1 part of dravyas (containing equal parts of Guduchi, Amalaki, Bibhitaki, haritaki and Danti) with 16 parts of water. When it remains to 4 liter, it is cooled. The drugs have following properties:

Study Population: Study will be carried out on the patients suffering from the sign and symptoms of Vataj Yoniroga, those attending IPD and OPD of our college's hospital.

Selection Criteria:-Inclusion Criteria:

The criteria of diagnosis was based on clinical parameters of Vataj Yoniroga i.e.

- Pipilika a sensation as if ants are crawling in vagina
- Supti- numbness in vagina
- Phena & Ruksha frothy & dry menses
- Aayas weakness
- Female having age 15 years to 60 years

Exclusion Criteria:

- Female having age below 15 years and above 60 years age
- Chronic diseases of vagina
- Cervical polyp
- Primary condition of carcinoma of cervix
- Tuberculosis of cervix

Withdrawal Criteria:

The Patients will be withdrawn from the trial if

- 1. If Patient himself want to discontinue the treatment anytime during the study.
- 2. If patient have any side effect/adverse drug reaction. Treatment and management of these patients will be done accordingly in our hospital.
- 3. Patient who fails to report for follow up or shows irregularity in treatment.





- Guduchi, Bibhitaki, haritaki and Danti decreases amount of vitiated vata by its ushna veerya. Amalaki gives strength to patients. Hot
